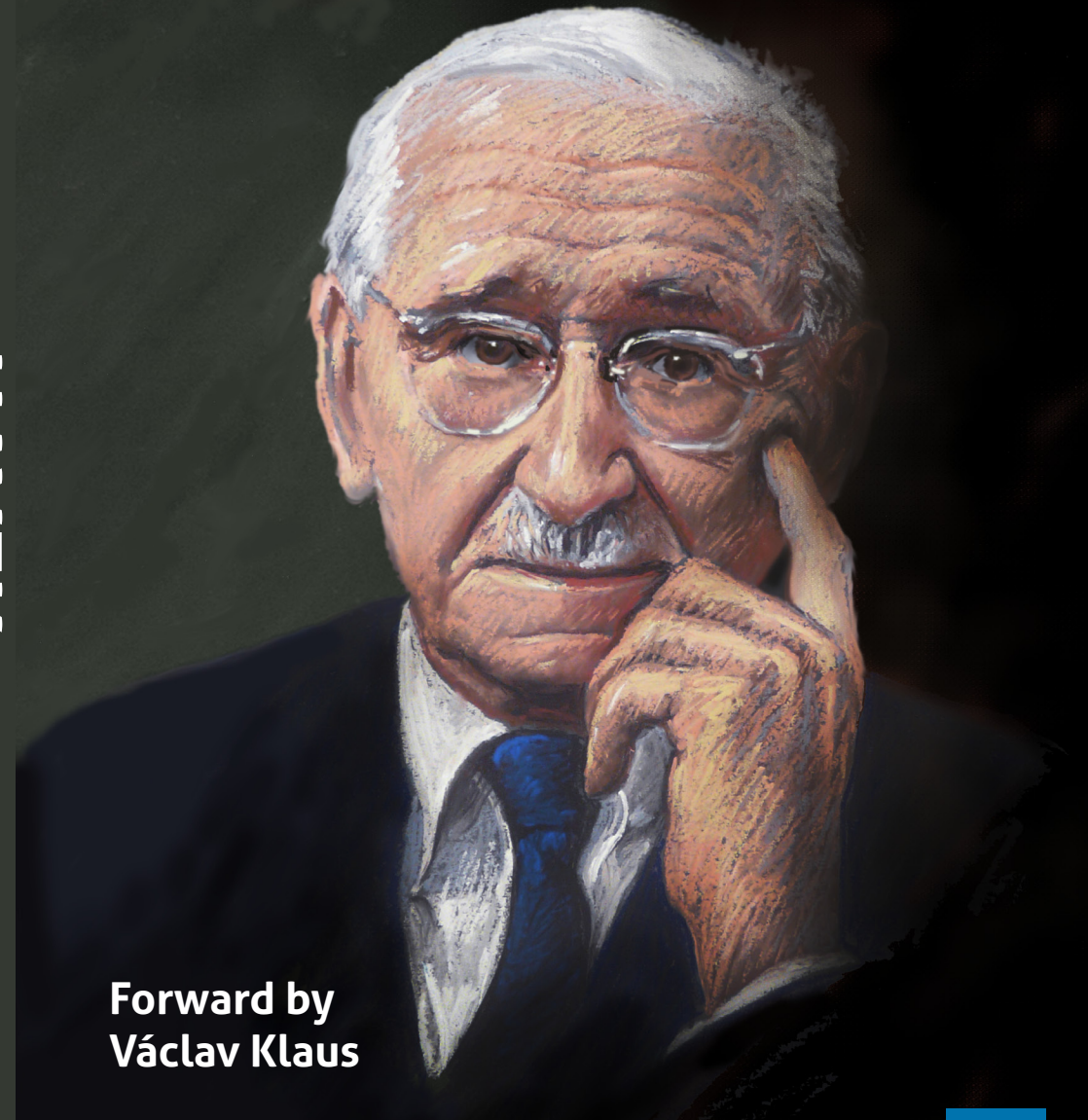


The Essential HAYEK
